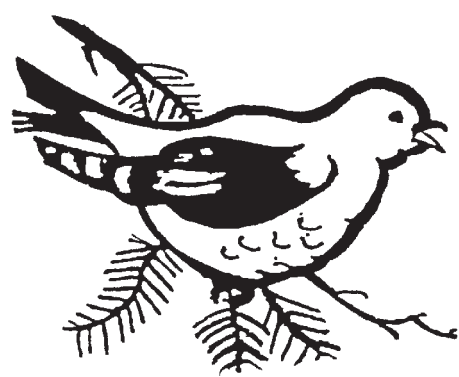

Lengby Lutheran Parish welcomes new pastor

A beautiful September Sunday was the perfect setting for the installation of Reverend Gene Lilienthal as Pastor of the Lengby Lutheran Parish. The installation took place at

4:30 pm on Sunday, September 13, 2015 at Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Bagley. Serving as liturgist was Reverend Jeff Merseith (Oklee Parish) and the lector was Reverend

John Merseith Sr. of Audubon. The sermon was delivered by Pastor Lilienthal's son, Reverend Michael Lilienthal of Iola, Wisconsin and was based on John 12:20-33; "The Lutheran

Pastor mentions the Cross of Christ." Officiant for the installation was Reverend Nicholas Proksch of East Grand Forks. A ham supper was served by the ladies aid.

Pastor Lilienthal was born and raised in the Glencoe, Minnesota area. He obtained his bachelor's degree from Concordia Lutheran College in St. Paul, Minnesota and went on to further study at Concordia Lutheran Theological Seminary in Ft. Wayne, Indiana. He later transferred to Bethany Theological Seminary, Mankato, Minnesota. After receiving his Master of Divinity degree, he was called to serve as pastor of Bethany Lutheran Church, Luverne, MN and Rose Dell Trinity Lutheran Church, Jasper, MN. Most recently, he has been Pastor of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Brownsburg, Indiana. He and his wife Cyndie have four children.

The Lengby Lutheran Parish consists of Our Savior's Lutheran Church of Bagley and St. Paul Lutheran Church in Lengby, members of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod (ELS), a bible-believing Lutheran synod in fellowship with the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS).

Threshing grain has started in the Amish community near Gonvick



Threshing grain is separating the loosened chaff from the grain. Today it is done mostly by a combine which can harvest, thresh and winnow the grain while it is in the field. The large machines that are used can automatically thresh and separate the grain and puts it into a grain wagon that is ready to haul to local elevators.

Last week at the David Mast residence south west of

Gonvick was a little different as a crew of Amish was busy gathering the stalks of grain that had been stood up for drying.

Two wagons hitched up to work horses went into the field with several people tossing the sheaves up onto the wagon. When it was high enough they went back to where the threshing machine was ready to run the grain through to separate the grain.

IRS Imposters Continue to Call

Tax season may be over, but criminals posing as Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") agents continue to call Minnesotans and attempt to intimidate them into paying money. These criminals use a variety of ploys to lure victims, including using fake names, false IRS badge numbers, and even reciting the victim's mailing address or the last four digits of their Social Security Number. The callers may threaten arrest, jail time, driver's license and passport revocation, and other legal action, unless the victim pays for purported back taxes or fines supposedly owed to the IRS.

In many cases, it can be difficult to detect these fraudsters, who often call from outside the United States. They use "spoofing" technology to hide the origin of their calls. Spoofing is used by these scammers to make a Washington D.C.

Polk County Sheriff

The Polk County Sheriff's Office has received complaints of a couple of scams that are still going on in the county. One of the scams is an IRS scam. Someone is calling saying they are from the IRS and they are calling about an ongoing lawsuit and the caller is to return a phone call to the IRS, with a phone number provided. If you are not aware of this lawsuit, do not call the number back. Call your local Law Enforcement.

The second scam is where a caller is saying that they are a grandson or relative of the person they are calling and they are in some trouble. They ask for money to be wired to the location that they are to help them with their troubles. Ask questions from this person, and then attempt to contact that family member to make sure everything is alright with them.

There are more scams out there as well and the Polk County Sheriff's Office asks that everybody is aware of these scams and try to stay up on scams that are out there. If you suspect something to be a scam please call the Polk County Sheriff's Office, 218-281-0431.

telephone number appear on a resident's caller ID, thereby masking their identity and evade law enforcement.

The Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration ("TIGTA") notes that these scammers make more than 10,000 calls per week. In the past two years, victims of this scam have reportedly lost \$15 million.

If you receive a call that appears to come from the IRS, remember that the IRS does NOT:

1. Ask for credit or debit numbers over the phone;
2. Require you to use one specific method to pay back taxes; nor
3. Threaten to bring in local police or other law-enforcement groups to have you arrested for failure to pay taxes.

The best way to handle such a call is to hang up the phone. Speaking with the scammers may encourage them to call again.

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Ask a Trooper

Question-I spend a fair amount of time on the highway and often see passengers in vehicles with their feet on the dash. How can their seat belts be in the proper location to do their job? What would happen in the case of an air bag deployment?

Answer-Great question. There is no law that prohibits a passenger from placing their feet on the dashboard while the vehicle is in motion.

However, passengers who put their feet up in a moving vehicle could be putting themselves at even greater risk of injury in the event of a crash. It comes down to using good judgement. I would bet that most passengers never think about what could happen to them in the event of a collision when the airbags deploy.

Airbags are designed to cushion the head and chest of an adult passenger sitting in an upright position when wearing a correctly fitted seatbelt. If the passenger is sitting incorrectly, there is a greater risk of injury in a crash. This could result in their knees being forced into their chest or face that could cause a serious injury or death. There is also a risk of leg fractures or spinal injuries.



Below are some recommendations and information on airbag safety from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

•When there is a moderate to severe crash, a signal is sent from the air bag system's electronic control unit to the inflator within the air bag module.

•An igniter in the inflator starts a chemical reaction that produces a harmless gas, which inflates the air bag within the blink of an eye - or less than 1/20th of a second.

•Side-impact air bags inflate even more quickly since there is less space between the occupant and the striking object, such as the interior of the vehicle, another vehicle, a tree, or a pole.

•Because air bags deploy very rapidly, serious or sometimes fatal injuries can occur if the occupant is too close to - or is in direct contact with - the air bag when it first begins to deploy.

•Sitting as far back from the steering wheel or dashboard as possible and using seat belts help prevent occupants from being "too close" to a deploying frontal air bag.

I highly recommend that you do not place your feet on the dashboard while the vehicle is in motion.

Let the Spring Flooding Predictions Begin...

As we inch closer and closer to freezing, we also inch closer to the potential for spring flooding. This isn't new for the Red River Basin and it is known that Mother Nature tends to have a mind of her own when revealing indicators of spring flooding or drought.

In the spring of 2015, we cruised through winter relatively unscathed which led us to believe that a drought was looming. The ground was brown and had little snow cover in many areas of the basin. Precipitation for 2015 had been below average for all months except for May when we received over 7 inches of rain fell in some parts of the Red River basin helping to alleviate the drought conditions. Essentially one large rainfall can change the game.

Precipitation is a critical indicator in the flood prediction game. Here is a quick and simple glimpse at some of the basic indicators to predicting a spring flood:

- Fall Precipitation - The amount of rain or snow that falls in an area during the fall months (September, October and November).
- Winter Snowpack - The amount of snow that falls in an area throughout the winter.
- Spring Snowmelt - When the snow melts in the spring (March, April and May).
- Spring Temperature - How warm is it throughout the spring.
- Spring Precipitation The amount of rain or snow that falls in an area during the spring

If you think you have what it takes to be a flood predictor, you can play the indicator game to predict future water flows
