Yes it is fair time in Clearwater County

This summer marks the 116th Clearwater County Fair in Bagley, MN. It is being held August 2nd thru the 6th. Come and enjoy the free gate admission, great food, and fun! Mark your calendars early so you don't miss "Armband Night" Wednesday night from 6-10 pm and ride for \$20, the best economy for rides. Also, there are Motocross Races at 6 pm in the grandstand, admission \$10 youth, \$15 adults where high-flying excitement is brought by DMC Motorsports of Brooks, MN.

Thursday at 6 pm you can watch Olson's Pedal Tractor Pull in the grandstand and cheer the youth who are competing (ages 4-11). This is sure to be a hit!

Friday is just as exciting, with Rhythm & Ride in the horse arena at 2 pm presenting educational demos and the Rhythm & Ride Showcase Event starts at 6 pm. Look for the "hat" to make a donation to support local events and building. Also Friday, attend the

Pickup Pulls in the grandstand at 6 pm featuring street-legal pickups, while they smoke, roar and raise a ruckus – youth \$10, adult \$15. There will be free music on and off throughout the fair on the stage in the Pines.

Kick off Saturday early with a Flea Market and Craft Show from 9-4. Don't forget that one man and one woman will be named as Senior Citizen of the Year at 11 am at the Stage in the Pines. Tractor and Semi-Pulls in the grandstand will be held at noon. These are out-of-field big rigs by Bud Mathison with 8 tractor classes – youth \$10, adult \$15. Don't go home yet, because at 6 pm Saturday you can attend a Demo Derby for youth 12 and below \$10, adults \$15.

Sunday is the big finale! There are Corgi Races at 12 pm and admission is a free will donation. Then, souped-up trucks and cars race around at 3 pm for Baja Racing, in the grandstand (with many humps and bumps) – youth \$10, adults \$15.

Correction on voter approval

The Clearbrook-Gonvick School Board at their meeting on Monday, July 17 passed a resolution to issue General Obligation Facilities Maintenance Bonds. The information on the project had been submitted to the Commissioner of Education for capital improvements. The project only needs board approval which they passed at their meeting. The state legislature has given to local school boards the ability to raise funds for three areas. Indoor Air Quality, Fire Suppression and Asbestos removal. The board chose the

Indoor Air Quality which included HVAC, Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning. Total for that would be \$2,745,000. The Health and Save Bond Issue **which would not need voter approval. That would be sent to the auditor to place on tax payers in the district.**

What would need voter approval would be the General Obligation School Building Bonds that will go up for a vote in the future. That total is \$28,370,000 and with interest for a total of \$47,749,461 over a 20-year period for the district.

(NELL) is getting ready to kick off the Fall 2023 lineup

Northern Exposure to Lifelong Learning (NELL) is getting ready to kick off the Fall 2023 lineup. NELL is celebrating its 20th year of bringing quality programs to Clearwater and East Polk Counties.

In 2003 the program was funded by the Minnesota Humanities Commission to serve rural communities in North-Central Minnesota. In its first year of operation, the targeted service area of the organization were the communities of Bagley, Clearbrook, and Gonvick. Currently, the service area includes all Clearwater and East Polk County.

Northern Exposure to Lifelong Learning was originally conceived as the lifelong learning component of the ad hoc Center for Retirement and Learning. In its first two years of operation, NELL operated as an unincorporated entity. Because of the success of the program and name recognition, Northern Exposure to Lifelong Learning submitted articles of incorporation November 2004 to the State of Minnesota, was officially incorporated as a stand-alone non-profit corporation, 501(c)(3), December 2004.

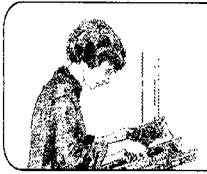
