The Bagley Cemetery Walk will be Sunday August 27 at 1:30 pm. Participants will meet at the Chapel in the Bagley City Cemetery. Some of the pioneers included in the walk are Ole Lee, Maude Arney, Mae Barness, D.C. Bjornby, Jerome

Thayer and others.

The Shevlin Cemetery walk will be Sunday September 10. Participants will meet at The History Center in Shevlin and will be taken by horse and wagon to the Shevlin City Cemetery and the Clearwater Lutheran Cemetery. There will be two tours: one at 1:00 and again at 2:30. Early Shevlin pioneers like the Rauk Family, The Gordon's, Thorps, Krohns and others will be included.

Participants should wear comfortable shoes and be prepared to walk some distance.
